4. QUESTIONS/QUERIES FOR COMMITTEE FROM REGION (IF ANY)

Hitchin are happy to host a DMT qualifier event if required.

Still waiting to secure a venue for the regional compulsory final. We would like to make this different to the qualifying events. This may include walk on with music, large presentations etc to differentiate.

RP to get a cost for hire of equipment from Gymaid for a competition at a venue where equipment would need to be brought in.

5. AOB

We hope to be in a position to run coach/gymnast development sessions in the future. Further discussions are likely to be held through the year at committee meetings.

There is a grant available from ECGA for clubs which must be claimed by the end of the year. Clubs should be encouraged to apply for this.

• Action: RP to send another note around to remind clubs.

Question - Is there any way to request BG to bridge the gap between NDP 7 and performance? (Regional to National). There is a TTC annual meeting which is only now 2 hours, (reduced from one day a couple of years ago), and not easily accessible to request changes or ask questions.

• Action: will be discussed at the next committee meeting.

Regional competition cups are still available and being stored. We should look at a way to encompass this into a competition during the next year.

• Action: SK to propose a format to be discussed at next committee meeting.

Schools competition – we are hosting 2 of the schools competitions this year – they have previously used our equipment to host these competitions and they pay for this.

• Action: NW to speak to Cheryl to see if they require the equipment again this year.

COMMITTEE NEWS

The Trampoline Technical committee have not yet held our AGM so the committee remains the same at the moment

We have had several meetings during the year and are trying to find a means to hold "virtual" meetings via video link (or something else) as getting people together seems to be getting more difficult.

COMPETITIONS

The number of gymnasts at competitions is continuing its upward trend and an entry of around 300 is usual for the NDP competitions, the increase of the entry fee to £15.00 does not seem to have affected numbers Most regional NDP competitions in 2017/18 have continued to be to be run from the Cambridge University (CUTC) site due to its excellent facilities, space, central location and ability to run DMT and trampoline concurrently, albeit with DMT moving costs and effort.

DMT is now integrated into every competition though numbers for this are still low and is effectively being subsidised by the trampolining entries. Costs and effort to move a DMT, landing area and biscuit mats for every competition cannot be sustained indefinitely –

Outside of the regional NDP competitions we continue to support the running of other competitions for clubs, opens and regional championships – the most recent being in Wisbech for Fenland Flyers.

Roman Steel perhaps deserves a special mention at the regional team finals as he had to compete both trampoline and DMT in the same flight, compromising his warmups somewhat and requiring him to hurry between the apparatus, changing in and out of his stirrups as he went. Though exhausted he did it all with splendid humour and it was fitting that he achieved some success in one of the events.

SQUAD

Region have chosen not to run any squad sessions in 2017/18 while looking at the most effective ways to share coaching knowledge and expertise across the region.

JUDGING COURSES

Our region is fortunate to have Andrew Jones (National Judging organiser) and Andrew Aistrup (National Judge) within region, so we have been well served with judge courses at club, and county level this year and have a number of new judges



Regional Team Manager - Pat Dodson

Largest team at team finals 2nd trampoline 6th DMT, 90 participants, 27 medals. HBS were a large part of the team, deserve a special mention. 60 went on to finals, competing for their clubs, 29 earned medals from this event. We do well with the younger, lower levels. Still comparably weak in the higher levels – performance etc, relatively few in the higher levels.

BG have removed NDP 7 so there is a big move from NDP 6 to performance level.

Gymnast and coach development sessions might help move performance forward.



Welfare Officer - Karly Good

A new Ethics and Welfare team based at Lilleshall consisting of 3 team members was established as well as a Safeguarding Officer for the South (including covering East Region) was employed by British Gymnastics.

British Gymnastics updated many of their policies including adding some new guidance on Managing Challenging Behaviour.

GDPR came into place within British Gymnastics.

No Welfare matters to report.

Three Time to Listen courses were run in the region.

A British Gymnastics South Conference took place in May in Crawley for 6 regions in the south of England. Sadly only one Club Welfare Officer from the whole region attended.

Regional Welfare Officers were provided with British Gymnastics email addresses for Welfare reporting and identification cards for when carrying out club visits and attending official British Gymnastics events.

Teresa O'Neill stepped down as County Welfare Officer for Hertfordshire. She was thanked for all her commitment and support within Welfare in the region.

All of our Club and County Welfare Officers are doing a great job, taking time out of their already very busy schedules to deal with any problems that arise. As Regional Welfare Officers, myself and Verity Adams are extremely grateful for their continued commitment. There are still currently vacancies for Hertfordshire, Essex and Norfolk County Welfare Officers. If anyone knows of anybody that may be interested, please contact Karly.

The intention is to continue to run all four of the Level 3 modules in the Region each year, while there is demand. There are only 3 active Level 3 tutors operating, as such this Region does play host a large number of candidates from outside the Region

BG has agreed that the best way to progress Level 3 assessments is to provide Assessment days, that the candidates travel to, rather than the assessor travelling to the candidates location. As such, this Region has now successfully hosted 2 such days and more are planned in 2019

Coach Education remains an integral part of the activities of British Gymnastics and our Region is delighted to continue to host courses that continue to be the bench-mark of quality and consistency.
