## Minutes

- Last meeting matters arising and approval.
  - Welfare officer and competition organiser positions should be added to the officials list so these are recorded and visible to all clubs.
  - Schools competition Should we be charging the Schools committee for the provision of IT equipment? Agreed that from 2018 schools a cost will be required for this support – suggested £2 per participant. NW to take up with schools coordinator.
  - Can we ask BG to remove zero scoring for NDP grades? NP to put proposals in an email and circulate for discussion/debate.
- Committee reports approval and matters arising from.
- Regional team finals team and further details
  - Around 90 participants this year, up from 70 in 2017. Mainly due to increase in DMT.
  - NW spoken briefly to Carmel from tumbling at Performance Symposium, with limited success.

- ECGA have agreed to fund t-shirts in 2018. Likely to need a few more leotards also which ECGA have been made aware of. In previous years there has been a nominal contribution to coaches who are on the team, however this is not likely to be available this year. Looking at alternatives funding? Probably too short notice at this stage for 2018. Pat will make the coaching team aware that they may not get any reimbursement for their hotel etc.
- Regional get-together should make a profit this year which could go towards the funding.
- T-shirts for the coaches will be funded by ECGA as long as they are returnable and not dated. Committee agreed.
- Regional coaching team will be decided on by Pat, reflecting on experience and make up of the team. Should be finalised by end March.
- All participants should be Silver members, if not already.
- Competition officials what can we do to ensure clubs provide adequate
  judges/officials, and sanctions for those not providing adequate officials either in
  advance or on the day. (Follow up conversation from last meeting)
  - Need to enforce the 'absent judge' rule, with the fines being increased for repeat non-attendees. £25 fine for each absent official. £50 for next, £100 for third competition. If the fee is paid and at a subsequent competition the required officials are provided the fine is back to zero.
  - NP to add the fine to the entry fee for the next competition so this is paid at the next competition. NP/AA/RP to have spreadsheet of clubs requiring fines to ensure these are paid.
  - Form to not allow non-qualified roles to be selected where a qualified role is required.
- Venues for 2018/9 season.
  - Cambridge University have informed us that the venue will not be available for the NPD competition for the foreseeable future.

Brentwood can offer a trampoline only venue, Harlow (new venue) – NP will visit
the site for suitability. We would need to provide 2 x trampolines and DMT.
Hatfield is a possibility, Colchester may be a possible – NW to speak to Crystelle
to see if this is a possibility. Alternatively, we could run the competitions over 2
days, or run trampoline and DMT separate. Felt that at least one competition
and the regional compulsory final should host both Trampoline and DMT. All
committee to investigate possible venues and costs.

## AOB

- Proposal host club to waive up to 3 non-qualified officials from their requirement at a competition as they will be helping with the organisation/set up etc. NW to speak to AA regarding this.
- Nicki Weller informed the committee that Jenni Morgan, ECGA secretary has passed away suddenly. Stuart Kelly will be attending the funeral to represent Trampoline.
- New Norfolk county rep RP to email NP with details.
- Officials attire AA not happy with some officials' attire. Reminder to be sent out to all clubs ahead of next season along with the notes on fines etc.
