## **Opening Hours & Facilities**

The Sports Centre doors officially open at 08:30 on Sundays, the doors to the main hall should be open shortly after that. The café upstairs will be serving hot & cold drinks throughout the day and cooked snacks (bacon/sausage sandwiches, chips etc...) from around 09:00.

If you are looking for something else to do whilst in Brentwood the following local attractions are recommended:

- King George's Playing Fields kid's playground, skate-Park, adventure golf and woodland walks. Turn right out of car park, straight over traffic lights approx. ½ mile on the left.
- Hopefield Animal Sanctuary Started with just Horses, now everything from Alpacas to Exotic mammals via Iguanas and Rabbits (entry fee applies). Turn left out of car park, left at war memorial and 1st on right, drive to the very end of Sawyers Hall Lane.


## Parking At Brentwood School Sports Centre

The map shows the main parking areas available:

A – The Senior School Car Park. Please note that there will be other users of the centre trying to park, so please do park considerately maximising the spaces available. There is some overflow parking behind the wooden fence accessed near the corner of the main car park.

If parking against the end wall of the sports hall, please park at 90° to the wall in order to maximise parking spaces.

**C** – On-Street Parking. Middleton Hall Lane grew some extra double yellow lines last year but there is still space for some to park on single yellow lines. Other areas of either single yellow or Monday-Saturday only restrictions include Shenfield Crescent, Sawyers Hall Lane and one or two smaller locations.
