Possible competition in 2021	<p>28/11/21 agreed as being most suitable date. Venue TBC</p> <p>To be run using the new BG 2022 structure, club and regional grades but maybe not all club grades depending on numbers.</p> <p>Email to be sent out to clubs to ask if they would compete and if so, approx. number of gymnasts. The information to be used to establish potential numbers and a suitable venue.</p> <p>KG may not be in attendance as Welfare officer. DK agreed to cover the role if required.</p>	<p>RP to send email out.</p> <p>Suitable venue to be booked once approx. numbers are known.</p>
BG competition structure 2022	<p>Qualification criteria to the inter-regional competition can be defined by the region. NW suggested a sub-committee to write the criteria, which should be in place by the start of the competition year (Jan 2022).</p> <p>Time of Flight needs to be in place for regional competitions run from 2022. It would be good to have this in place for the November competition. Various options are available (Stopwatch, Veriflite, AirTime), a system acceptable to BG is required by January.</p> <p>Further discussions are required once more information is obtained to establish next course of action</p>	<p>NW to discuss with LO and approach AA to be part of a sub-committee to write the criteria.</p> <p>NW to speak to Graham at Ministry of Air regarding the Veriflite system.</p> <p>NW to speak to Andrew Aistrup to get a cost of the AirTime system.</p> <p>NW to propose costs to ECGA in August as whatever method is used it is likely to require funding.</p>
Trampoline-East Survey	<p>Results of the Trampoline-East survey have been sent to Duncan Hart at BG after approval from clubs. Duncan will be contacting clubs directly where BG may be able to assist.</p>	<p>No further action from committee. Item closed.</p>
Welfare matters	<p>Karly informed the committee that there are many more gymnasts with mental ill health than ever before. We would like to encourage clubs to have open, transparent, 2-way communication with parents around the gymnasts physical and mental well-being. This being club led, will encourage parents to also be open with clubs.</p> <p>Coaches are not seeing parents currently due to COVID restrictions so conversations are limited.</p>	<p>KG agreed to put together some information to be sent out to clubs to pass on to parents with some information and links to services which may be helpful.</p>
